If you intend to qualify for Region 5 teams to the North American Youth Championships, then please make sure you take note of the application structure for 2024. Applications submitted between March 13th and April 23rd are \$100 and the final application deadline is May 7th, but it will cost you \$300 to apply between April 24th and May 7th. At this point in time, absolutely no applications will be accepted after May 7th. If you plan to compete for NAYC, please also be sure to contact Joan Clay, our Region Coordinator for the FEI Juniors and Young Riders and let her know your intent. The 2024 NAYC will be held at the Great Lakes Equestrian Festival, Flintfields Horse Park, Traverse City, Michigan – July 30 - August 4, 2024. If you're a rider, PLEASE DON'T FORGET TO TURN IN YOUR DECLARATIONS! We currently only have 2 Juniors and 2 Young Riders declared as of the end of March.

For the US Dressage Final – November 7-10, 2024 at the Kentucky Horse Park – new this year! Prix St Georges and Intermediate I Junior/Young Rider Final classes will be offered!

- Effective December 1, 2023, entries for all horses competing in USEF-licensed competitions must include a USEF Horse ID number per <u>GR1101</u>.
- The USEF Horse ID is free, and you can apply to your <u>USEF Member Dashboard</u>.
- Existing ID numbers can be located using the <u>Horse Search</u>.
